SHARING THE LIGHT:

The ushers will come forward to receive the light from the Christ Candle and then proceed to light the candles of each person seated along the aisles. Pass the light to the person next to you, with the words, "The peace of Christ be with you". This sharing of the light is a way to symbolize our belief that God's love, revealed in the Light of the World, Jesus the Christ, is sufficient to overcome the darkness of our lives. Once you have passed the light:

Be still in the darkness of this sacred space, And listen to the quiet around you. For even in the quiet, there is the gentle being with others. Feel the warmth of this community, knowing you are not alone. For in the quiet shadow is the glow of life within all. Know, in the darkness, the gift each candle bears, A small flame, a diminutive light –
